

## GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

The State of São Paulo has signed a loan agreement with the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (hereinafter called The World Bank) amounting to US\$ 4.0 million for implementing the INTEGRATED WATER MANAGEMENT IN METROPOLITAN SÃO PAULO PROGRAM – *PROGRAMA MANANCIAIS*, with total estimated cost at US\$ 60,5 million. This Program is coordinated by the State Secretariat for Water Supply, Sanitation and Water Resources.

The proceeds of this loan will be applied for goods, works, related services and consultant services to be procured under this project, through competitive bidding and other procedures in accordance with the *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits, with the Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers* and with The Loan Agreement 7661-BR.

The MANANCIAIS Project will include the hiring of the following works, related services and goods:

### **Works:**

- Construction of housing units in Billings reservoir water basin;
- Implementation of landfill in the municipality of Embu Guaçu.

### **Services:**

- Organization of international seminars on water resources and urban upgrading;
- Training workshops for technical and environmental agents for implementation of water basin specific laws;
- Production of videos, educational material and road shows;
- Terminal deployment consultation and information relating to Alto Tietê water resources;
- Publications on water resources and urban management.

In addition to the works and services mentioned above, the State of São Paulo Government will also hire, under this Project, the following **consulting services** for strengthening of the implementation and management of the Mananciais Project and the Borrower:

- Evaluation plan of diffuse loads, drainage and floodplains;
- Analysis and evaluation of concentrated pollutant loads;
- Identification, planning and project future interventions in Alto Tietê water basin Areas of Environmental Protection and Recovery (APRM);
- Revision and completion of Development Plans and Environmental Protection – PDPA;
- Implementation of environmental and land use monitoring system;
- Development and deployment of the monitoring program of land use and occupation;

- Monitoring of environmental quality;
- Development of research among the user and beneficiary population of the Program;
- Definition of monitoring indicators and baseline;
- Independent environmental auditing;
- Program financial management auditing;
- Studies on the APRM's to: (i) assessment of the operational capacity of landfills and (ii) illegal disposal of solid waste.

It is estimated that specific procurement notices shall occur from May 2011.

Notices of public bidding and selection of national consultants will be published in the Diário Oficial do Estado de São Paulo, and in a newspaper of wide national circulation. Notices of public bidding and selection of international consultants will be published in addition to the indicated newspapers, in the journal Development Business and dgMarket.
